- ✓ Section 507 of the 1990 Clean Air Act (CAA) Amendments requires states and territories to set up programs to help small businesses

WHY IS SMALL BUSINESS ENVIRONMENTAL COMPLIANCE ASSISTANCE IMPORTANT?



- >46% of Illinoisans are employed by small businesses (2.5 million)
- >80% of net new job growth & capital investment comes from Illinois' existing businesses.
- Costs per employee of environmental regulations are more than 4 times higher in small firms than in large firms

WHO DO WE HELP?

- ✓ Thousands of small businesses subject to National Emission Standards for Hazardous Air Pollutants (NESHAP)
- ✓ Roughly 80% Air permitted or registered sources are small businesses (area sources)
- √4000+ small businesses are registered under the IEPA's Registration of Smaller Sources (ROSS) Program
- ✓ Small Businesses impacted by other state and federal air regulations
