- 3. If you have been in College for one (1) year or less or are still in High School: Official High School transcript including ACT or SAT scores.
- 4. **Original** Essay explaining: (Students should not submit the same essay for multiple years)
 - a) Outline your interest in and/or connection to the Illinois aggregates industry;
 - b) how your chosen field will apply to work in the Illinois aggregates industry;
 - c) your goals;
 - d) where you plan to attend College;
 - e) why you chose to apply for this scholarship; and
 - f) explain your financial need for the scholarship.
